### Summer Film Night

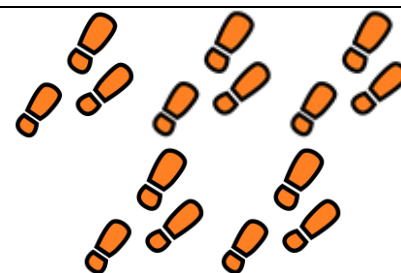

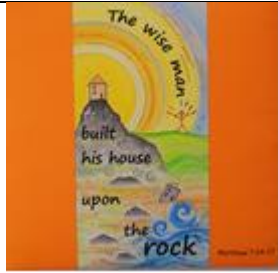
**Attendance** Pupils should attend school every day the school is open, unless they are really not well enough to. **Please do not send children with a temperature over 38.**

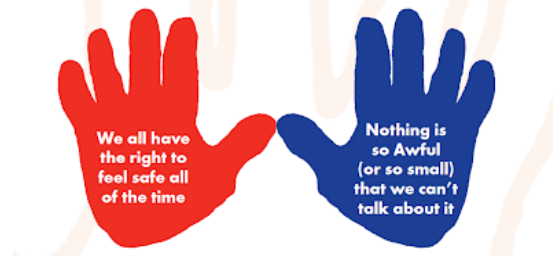


## All Saints' Vision

If you need to get in touch out of usual office hours, please contact the **Emergency Duty Team** immediately by calling **01926 886922**. If you think that **a child is at immediate risk**, call **999**.

### Do you have a pre-school child?

Did you know that if you have any questions or queries about your child's language development, you can make an appointment to have an informal chat with a speech and language therapist? To make an appointment you can telephone the speech and language department on 02476378620 and ask for 'an appointment for a drop-in session'. This will take place in Nuneaton and is a free service.



### Measles

**There are still cases of measles. Please ensure you remain vigilant.**

If your child has not had their MMR Vaccination and you would now like them to, or you are unsure if they should, please contact your GP to get this booked in or to discuss the vaccination with a medical professional.



# Should I keep my child off school?



## Yes

### Until...

Chickenpox	at least 5 days from the onset of the rash and until all blisters have crusted over
Diarrhoea and Vomiting	48 hours after their last episode
Cold and Flu-like illness (including COVID-19)	they no longer have a high temperature and feel well enough to attend. Follow the national guidance if they've tested positive for COVID-19.
Impetigo	their sores have crusted and healed, or 48 hours after they started antibiotics
Measles	4 days after the rash first appeared
Mumps	5 days after the swelling started
Scabies	they've had their first treatment
Scarlet Fever	24 hours after they started taking antibiotics
Whooping Cough	48 hours after they started taking antibiotics

Head lice	Tonsillitis
Threadworms	Slapped cheek
