
Summer Film Night

Do you have a pre-school child?

Did you know that if you have any questions or queries about your child's language development, you can make an appointment to have an informal chat with a speech and language therapist? To make an appointment you can



telephone the speech and language department on 02476378620 and ask for 'an appointment for a drop-in session'. This will take place in Nuneaton and is a free service.

Measles

There are still cases of measles. Please ensure you remain vigilant.

If your child has not had their MMR Vaccination and you would now like them to, or you are



unsure if they should, please contact your GP to get this booked in or to discuss the vaccination with a medical professional.





Should I keep my

child off school?

Yes

Until...

Chickenpox	at least 5 days from the onset of the rash and until all blisters have crusted over
Diarrhoea and Vomiting	48 hours after their last episode
Cold and Flu-like illness (including COVID-19)	they no longer have a high temperature and feel well enough to attend. Follow the national guidance if they've tested positive for COVID-19
Impetigo	their sores have crusted and healed, or 48 hours after they started antibiotics
Measles	4 days after the rash first appeared
Mumps	5 days after the swelling started
Scabies	they've had their first treatment
Scarlet Fever	24 hours after they started taking antibiotics
Whooping Cough	48 hours after they started taking antibiotics

but make sure you let their school or nursery know about...

Hand, foot and mouth	Glandular fever
Head lice	Tonsillitis
Threadworms	Slapped cheek
