

	Almost all children can get the flu vaccine as a nasal spray. This is the recommended vaccine. The nasal spray contains gelatine and may not be acceptable for some parents.
	The nasal spray has gelatine. If this is not suitable, choose on the consent form the flu injection that is gelatine-free. These are expected to have lower effectiveness.
	If you have more than 1 child at the school you will need to complete a separate form for each child. You can do this by clicking on the link again. Please make sure it is your child's name and date of birth recorded on the form. Before submitting the form, please check details are correct

Before & After School Care

If your child is in Reception through to Year 6 and you would like to use our before or after school club please contact the school office.

Breakfast Club is open for drop offs between 7.30am and 8.30am for £3.00 per session, payable in cash on the day or in advance. This will be increasing after the October half term holiday to £4.00 per child.

After school sessions are from 3.15pm until 5.00pm Monday to Friday, at a cost of £10 per session. Half sessions are currently available, these are from 3.15pm until 4.30pm or from after school sports club until 5.00pm at a cost of £7 per session. Late collections will be charged at £5 per 15 minutes.

After school club must be booked and paid for in advance, via the app or in the office.
