Dear families,

As you are aware at school we encourage our children to be 'Golden'. We have, six Golden behaviours which we expect our children to follow, and these are:

- I am ready to learn
- I am following instructions
- I am showing good manners
- I am looking after our school
- I am showing respect to others at all times
- I am showing good sitting, looking and listening

In the autumn term we are going to trial an additional level to our behaviour policy. This is to encourage children to remain 'Golden'.

If a child receives a 'Golden reminder', they will have to spend two minutes at play time with the adult who issued the 'Golden reminder'. During this time, the child and adult will have a 'restorative conversation' about why they were given a reminder and how they can move forward in a positive way.

This is something we have already introduced during 'Happy Lunchtimes' and the children have responded well and there has been a large increase in the number of children showing 'Golden' behaviour at lunchtimes.

If this change is successful and the number of children showing 'Golden' behaviour increases during the school day, the current behaviour policy will be amended for the spring term.
