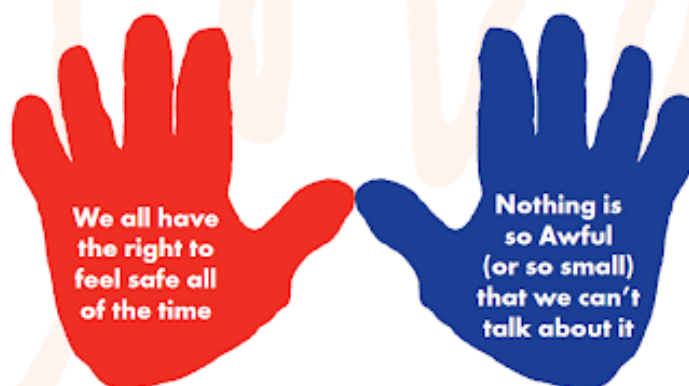

Sports Day

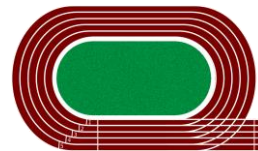
Sports Day for Years 1 – 6 will be held at The Pingles Stadium next Tuesday 21st May. Adults are invited to attend the stadium to support the children. The day will be split into two sessions, Years 4, 5 & 6 will be participating in the morning, their adults are welcome to come and watch at 10am. Children will walk back to school for lunch. Years 1, 2 & 3 will be participating in the afternoon. They will eat lunch at school, then walk to the Pingles Stadium. Their adults are welcome to attend from 1pm. Afternoon children may be able to go home with their adult from The Pingles, they MUST be signed out by their teacher, all other children will walk back to school.

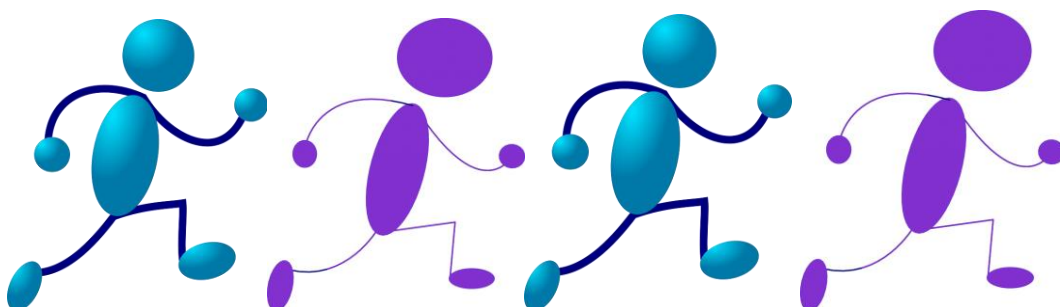


Nursery and Reception Sports morning is next Thursday 23rd May.

All Saints Voices

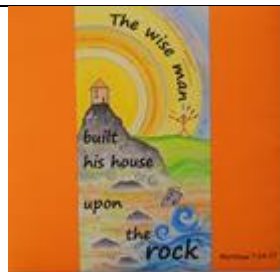

There are still cases of measles. Please ensure you remain vigilant.

If your child has not had their MMR Vaccination and you would now like them to, or you are

unsure if they should, please contact your GP to get this booked in or to discuss the vaccination with a medical professional.





Should I keep my child off school?



Yes

Until...

Chickenpox	at least 5 days from the onset of the rash and until all blisters have crusted over
Diarrhoea and Vomiting	48 hours after their last episode
Cold and Flu-like illness (including COVID-19)	they no longer have a high temperature and feel well enough to attend. Follow the national guidance if they've tested positive for COVID-19.
Impetigo	their sores have crusted and healed, or 48 hours after they started antibiotics
Measles	4 days after the rash first appeared
Mumps	5 days after the swelling started
Scabies	they've had their first treatment
Scarlet Fever	24 hours after they started taking antibiotics
Whooping Cough	48 hours after they started taking antibiotics

Head lice	Tonsillitis
Threadworms	Slapped cheek
