Before & After School Care

Our Before and After School Clubs are available to all children in Reception through to Year 6. Breakfast Club is open for drop offs between 7.30am and 8.30am for £3.00 per session. This will be increasing after the October half term holiday to £4.00 per child. After school sessions are from 3.15pm until 5.00pm Monday to Friday, at a cost of £10 per session. Half sessions are currently available, these are from 3.15pm until 4.30pm or from after school sports club until 5.00pm at a cost of £7 per session. Late collections will be charged at £5 per 15 minutes.

After school club must be booked and paid for in advance, via the app or in the office. 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Flu Immunisation

If your child did not have their Flu Immunisation on Monday 7th October during the school session for whatever reason, parents can now book on and attend a local clinic venue for the vaccination. Appointments can be booked via the Swiftqueue link: https://www.swiftqueue.co.uk/userlogin.php

- * Please follow the below link to register on to the Swiftqueue system, you will need to attach an email address and telephone number to the account. You can make an account for yourself and add family members on https://www.swiftqueue.co.uk/userlogin.php Please Note: Appointment slots are 10 minutes maximum. If you think your child requires more time please contact the office on 02476 321550 prior to appointment.
- * Once you have made an account click on -> Book an Appointment and search for CWP in location -> Search
- * You will then see CWP Schools Immunisation Clinics select Jepson House for Nuneaton Clinics /Boughton Leigh Childrens Centre for Rugby Clinics/Woodloes House for South Warwickshire/Alcester Clinic for Alcester Clinics/City of Coventry Health Centre or Central Library for Coventry > Book an appointment
- *Click on the green 'School questionnaire tab' and type in your child's school -> Submit details -> next -> Select Immunisation-> select your preferred time and date -> next -> tick the Terms & Conditions boxes -> confirm.

Once you have made your appointment, you will receive an email and text confirmation.

The school nursing team have an Injectable Flu Vaccine Clinic for school aged children only at Edward Street Community Centre on Thursday 28th November from 3pm until 6pm, by appointment only.
