Subject: Music - Body and Tuned percussion

I	LG: to identify structure and texture in music	Kapow Music: Lesson I: Pitter patter raindrops Listening to the body percussion piece 'Rain Sound', children are introduced to the terms 'structure' and 'texture' and tasked with identifying these features within the music they hear	See Kapow music
a	LG: to use body percussion	Lesson 2: Rainforest body percussion  Children work in pairs to practice the 'Boom, Snap, Clap' rhythm using body percussion, personalising their sequence  Count the rhythm	
3	LG: to create musical rhythm using body percussion	Lesson 3: The rhythm of the forest floor  Children begin their rainforest compositions with the forest floor and understory layers, creating body percussion rhythms to suit the movement of the animals within those layers	

4	LG: to create simple tunes	Lesson 4: The loopy rainforest	
		Moving onto tuned percussion instruments, children create 'repeated melodies' or 'loops' for the canopy and emergent layers of the rainforest, taking into consideration pitch and tempo	
5	LG: to build and improve a composition	Lesson 5: Sounds of the rainforest  Children combine the four sections of their compositions, building structure through combining rhythms and melodies and adding dynamics and tempo
