


In my family, we recycle rubbish. We return things so they can be used again.
























This plastic can be used to make all kinds of things, including clothes — you might be wearing some!' said Mr Jones.





'Clothes, books and toys that you don't want can all be taken to the charity shop,' explained Mr Jones.






I told Mum and Dad about our trip to the recycling centre. Now we buy recycled things at the shops.


