1	LG identify physical and human features <i>See geography planning</i>	(Digimaps) where in the world are we? Using maps, atlases, globes and digital mapping to locate countries and describe features studied.	Sketch, map, field work, human & physical features, Key Sketch map, human & physical features Map, land use survey, Urban, rural, survey, Farming, agriculture, crop, topographic maps, compass points, grid reference.
2	LG: find the six-figure grid references of locations on a map using Digimap for Schools software <i>See geography planning</i>	Explore OS maps and use the four to eight points of a compass and 4/6 figure grid references to locate where we are and where our church is.	
3	LG: create a simple sketch map <i>See geography planning</i>	Sketch a map to show route to school. Use compass points and grid references. Explore route to church. What will we see on the way? Physical/human? RED/SEN - pre sketched map	
4	LG: visit to All Saints church Respect, tolerance	As geographers: sketch route inc physical and human features As historians: discover the history of All Saints and connections to WWII As artists: sketch parts of the church, graveyard or peace gardens
