Attendance and Punctuality for week beginning 18th November 2024

***Punctuality** The school gates open at **8:45am** & close at **8:55am** please arrive on time. If the gate is locked and your child arrives through the main office doors, they are arriving late, and will receive a late mark, please avoid this and take a moment to explain to the office staff the reason.*

Online Safety

We have recently had a few incidents with children using Snapchat whilst unsupervised in their bedrooms at home. Please be mindful that Snapchat is designed for adults. If you do allow your child to use Snapchat then please think carefully about how and when they have access to it. See below for further tips on how to use Snapchat safely.

Keeping Your Child Safe on Snapchat

Snapchat can be fun, but it also comes with serious risks. Here's what you need to know and how to help your child use it safely if you choose to allow them access:

Top Safety Tips

- **Privacy Settings:** Set to "My Friends Only" to limit contacts and enable "Ghost Mode" to hide their location.
- **Monitor Activity:** Regularly check their contacts and shared content. Block or report inappropriate material.
- **Open Communication:** Encourage your child to tell you about anything upsetting. Reassure them it's okay to ask for help.
- **Parental Controls:** Use apps to monitor their usage discreetly (see top apps below).

The Risks

- **Disappearing Messages:** Harmful content vanishes after viewing, making it hard to monitor.
- **Inappropriate Content:** Children can access or share unsuitable images and videos.
- **Cyberbullying:** Hurtful messages can be sent without evidence.
- **Online Strangers:** Strangers can send friend requests, risking grooming or exploitation.
- **Addictive Features:** Streaks and notifications encourage excessive screen time.

Take Action

- **Report Issues:** Use Snapchat's in-app tools to block or report users and inappropriate content.
- **Supervise Usage:** Set time limits and regularly check their account.
- **Evaluate Readiness:** Consider if Snapchat is suitable for your child's age and maturity.

Top 5 Parental Control Apps

1. **Bark** – Monitors social media activity and flags risks like bullying or explicit content.
2. **Qustodio** – Offers detailed app usage reports and screen time limits.
3. **Net Nanny** – Filters inappropriate content and tracks app usage.
4. **OurPact** – Allows you to block apps and set screen time schedules.
5. **Norton Family** – Provides location tracking, app blocking, and detailed activity reports

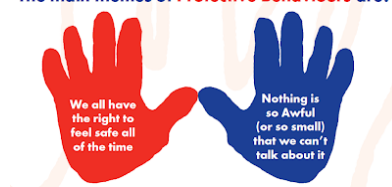

Half sessions are currently available, these are from 3.15pm until 4.30pm or from after school sports club until 5.00pm at a cost of £7 per session. Late collections will be charged at £5 per 15 minutes.

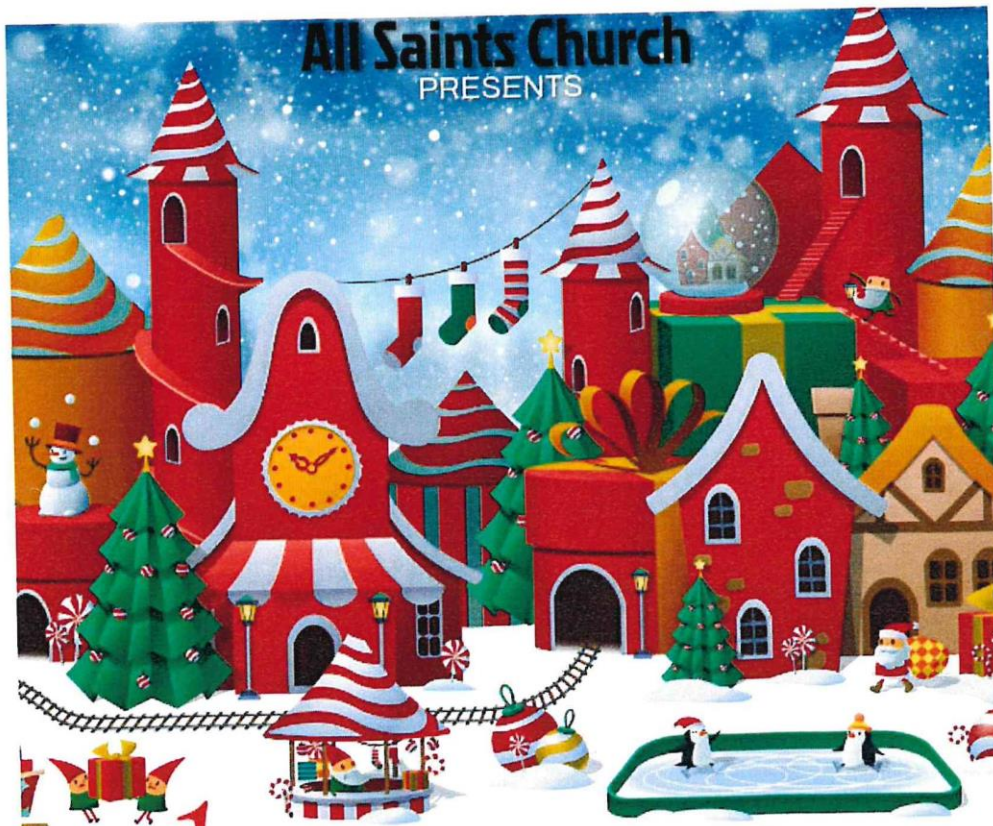
