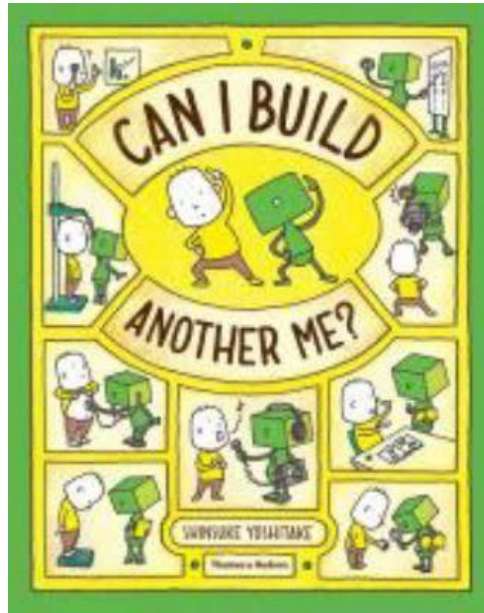

Topics in Year 1 – text based learning Autumn term

- All about me topic – geography links with local area.
- Transport topic – history links to how transport has changed.





Maths

Maths follows the white rose, children will learn to:
mastery of number to 20 including:

- addition,
- subtraction,
- sharing/dividing and multiplying using arrays,
- doubling and halving,
- money and coin recognition,
- properties of 2D and 3D shapes,
- telling the time to o'clock and half past.



Science in Year 1

Science topics:

- Animals including humans
- Body senses
- Plants and trees
- Seasons and materials

Children create a seasons booklet through the year and closely observe the changes in each season



Daily structure - mornings

- Registration
- Phonics – same structure as Reception
- Whole class input – English/Mathematics
- Continuous provision approach.
- Snack and KS1 playtime
- Maths meetings
- Daily readers



Daily structure - afternoon

- Lunch – everyone eats in the hall and then play on the main playground.
- Whole class input – non-core subject
- Continuous provision approach.
- Practical learning and small group activities to support basic skills.



Learning environment

- During Autumn and Spring term we work using a continuous provision approach.
- Lots of small group work.
- Spring term we introduce formal learning ready for Year 2.
- Encourage independent learning.



Homework

- Homework will be set on Fridays and due in no later than Tuesday - children will take red books home and bring back to school.
- Focus on key skills alternating focus with English and Maths.
- Rhino readers – reading books will be changed weekly. Please read with your child at home and comment in their reading diaries.
- Weekly spelling tests – spellings will be part of homework.



Uniform and PE

- Please ensure your child comes to school each day with their school bag. We expect every child to have a book bag/ their own school bag which can fit a A4 size book inside.
- Children are to wear the appropriate uniform each day unless informed otherwise.
- On PE days, children are to come into school wearing their PE kit. This includes appropriate foot wear.
