Nut Free School

Reminder - we are a NUT FREE school. Please do not send your child to school with foods containing nuts, including chocolate & nut spreads. Whilst we cannot ask children not to have nuts for breakfast, if they do, please ensure they wash their hands and face

afterwards. Do not allow children to eat nuts on their way into school, where they cannot remove the residue. Nut residue can cause anaphylaxis, we have children in school with nut allergies, residue can cause a reaction. Thank you for your cooperation.

Before & After School Care

Our Before and After School Clubs are available to all children in Reception through to Year 6. Breakfast Club is open for drop offs between 7.30am and 8.30am for £4.00 per session, payable in cash on the day or in advance.

After school sessions are from 3.15pm until 5.00pm Monday to Friday, at a cost of £10 per session. Half sessions are currently available, these are from 3.15pm until 4.30pm or from after school sports club until 5.00pm at a cost of £7 per session. Late collections will be charged at £5 per 15 minutes.

After school club must be booked and paid for in advance, via the app or in the office. Please note – children who attend the nursery here at All Saints School DO NOT automatically get a place in our reception class, you MUST apply for a place, as the selection process is carried out by Warwickshire County Council.

Attendance & Punctuality Reminder


What YOU must do:

- Telephone the school before 9:00am each day of your child's absence.
- Arrange medical appointments outside of school hours. Where this is not possible, tell the school in advance and bring in appointment cards/letters. We expect all children to be in school before and after their appointment time unless there are exceptional circumstances.
- If you are not sure whether your child is well enough to attend school, send them in anyway. We will always call you if they are unwell and they often feel better once they are at school.
- Have a backup plan for if your child misses transport or you have issues getting to school, call on a family member, neighbour or friend.
- If you and your child are experiencing difficulties with school attendance then talk to us as a first step so that we can help.
- Ensure your child arrives to school on time. School starts at 8:50am prompt. Being late to school disrupts your child's learning.
